



## Future Academies Project Manager

The Trust is seeking to appoint a project manager to support a masterplan development up to detailed planning submission for one of its schools in London. The building stock is in poor condition and the trust is seeking to rebuild the facilities. The Trust does not have access to any Department for Education funding and is looking to self-fund the project via developing a masterplan for the whole site and by selling off part of the site for residential development. It is intended that one development partner will be appointed to develop the school and residential elements of the project under a single development agreement.

The Trust has appointed a masterplan architect, and supporting design consultants, to develop an outline master-plan. The development of the school and residential neighbourhood are inextricably linked in planning terms and we have also made appointments to prepare a full detailed planning application for the integrated development. Further supporting consultants required to facilitate the application will be appointed at the appropriate point in the process. The Trust is seeking to submit a full planning application for the site in August 2019 and would like to appoint a project manager to manage the process up to achieving planning consent.
